

2010 Apple Dessert Bake-Off Rules

Please read and follow all of the instructions and rules below in order to ensure a positive experience for all of our participants.

1. All entrants should call Jennifer Koach at 502-227-2560 by 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday June 30 to notify LHHS of plans to enter bake-off.
2. Entrants must bring a completed entry form to Liberty Hall along with their dessert entry. Entry forms can be found at www.libertyhall.org/events.htm and at the LHHS front desk at the Orlando Brown House, Tuesday-Saturday, 10:00 a.m.-4:00 p.m.
3. All desserts should be made from scratch, including crusts, and all entries must contain apples as a main ingredient.
4. Entries should be baked in standard-size pans.
5. You may enter a maximum of three desserts per person.
6. More than one person may collaborate on a single dessert, but only one prize will be given.
7. The entry fee is \$5.00 per dessert. The desserts are given to Liberty Hall Historic Site as a donation, and may be sold to the public after the winners are announced. All proceeds from the bake-off will benefit Liberty Hall Historic Site and its programs.
8. Entries will be judged on: Appearance (including patriotic decoration), Taste, and Overall Satisfaction.
9. Judges will be independent volunteers not directly associated with Liberty Hall Historic Site, its staff or Board of Directors.
10. Entrants should bring their dessert(s) to Liberty Hall in a sealed container. Entrants should bring the desserts themselves because pictures will be taken on the entrants with their desserts.
11. Entrants must include a list of ingredients; they are encouraged to provide the recipe.

Entrants will receive a pickup stub so they get the correct plate/container back at the end of the event. |
