Education Volunteer

Education volunteers help with educational programs for adults, families, and children. Volunteers will learn education programs and then present or lead them. Volunteers may work alone or with a staff member. Assignments might include: crafts; spinning and/or weaving demonstrations; hearth cooking demonstrations; or story time. Education volunteers work on a regular schedule or on an as-needed basis. Education volunteers report to the Education & Volunteer Coordinator.

Responsibilities

- Learn basic history of Liberty Hall and the Orlando Brown House
- Learn education programs, as assigned
- Lead education programs for groups
- Research topics of interest and assist in developing new programs

Skills

- Self motivated
- Comfortable with public speaking
- Enjoys working with the public
- Able to work with children/seniors/other special groups

Requirements

- Should be available to work at least one Saturday afternoon each month, March-December
- Able to walk up and down stairs easily
- Are at least 16 years old
- A one year commitment
